

**Spanish I:** Introduce students to basic concepts of the Spanish language and the cultures of those who speak it. Includes greetings, common expressions, questions, and responses, Mexican culture and history, and traditional music and art.

**Spanish II:** Introduce students to more advanced concepts of the Spanish language and the cultures of those who speak it. Includes an introduction to verb conjugation, vocabulary lessons, and a study of Spanish speaking countries around the world as well as their history, music, art, and cultural practices.

**Spanish III:** Introduce students to more advanced concepts of the Spanish language and the cultures of those who speak it. Includes verb conjugation in different tenses, advanced vocabulary lessons, and a study of Spanish speaking countries around the world as well as their history, music, art, and cultural practices.

**Language Arts 8:** Practice and improve skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Focus on informative & argumentative writing, citation of evidence and elaboration, and development of themes in literature.

**Forensics:** Introduce students to advanced concepts of public speaking and debate. Practice and prepare for competition at forensics tournaments during the year.

**Forensics 8:** Introduce students to basic concepts of public speaking and debate. Practice events and prepare for participation in high school forensics.
