7th Grade Secondary Reading

The emphases in the 7th grade reading classes are two fold: to teach students to read increasingly difficult material with greater understanding, and to produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization, and style are appropriate to task, purpose, and audience. Students read informational texts, articles, essays, novels, and poetry. Reading skills, metacognitive skills, and higher-level comprehension work is incorporated. Students participate in daily free-choice reading in addition to the required assigned reading. Classes are organized around three domains: reading, writing, and vocabulary development.
