

## Foundations II:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) Foundations II is for students who want to further their artistic talents using many different types of media. You will learn how to observe the world both objectively and accurately. It will help you train your eye to see things as they truly are. This course revisits the art elements including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, and focuses mainly on the study of the art principles of design including: Balance, Unity, Contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, and Rhythm. It is a secondary course that focuses on honing artistic skills. We also discuss multiple facets of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today.

## Drawing:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) This Drawing course is for those students who love art and want to hone their drawing skills using media such as graphite, charcoal, colored pencils, markers, etc. This is a great course to take to learn how to control your artwork. This Drawing course leans heavily on the art elements and principles including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, Balance, Unity, Contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, and Rhythm. Students will take their art to the next level as we focus heavily on composition in this class. You will find that art is both creative and mathematically beautiful! It is designed to help students practice observing the world accurately and objectively. We also discuss multiple facets of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today.

## Painting:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) This Painting course is a great next step for those students who love color and want to bring vibrancy into their artwork. This Painting course leans heavily on the art elements and principles including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, balance, unity, contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, Rhythm. It is both an introductory and secondary course that focuses on honing artistic skills using solely painting media such as: watercolor, acrylic, pastel, and occasionally oil

paints. Students will take their art to the next level as we focus heavily on composition in this class. It is designed to help students practice observing the world accurately and objectively. We also discuss multiple facets of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today.

#### Commercial Art:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) Digital Art is everywhere around us and influences our everyday decisions. In Commercial Art we will take a closer look at the workings of the media that is in our lives every day! This Commercial Art course leans heavily on the art elements and principles including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, balance, unity, contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, Rhythm. It is both an introductory and secondary course that focuses on honing artistic skills using mostly digital media programs. It is designed to help students practice using today's digital resources to create art that is both beautiful and functional. We also discuss multiple facets of recent art history and the future of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today.

#### 3D Design:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) This 3D Design course gives students the opportunity to take their art into the 3D world. There are many opportunities in this course to work with clay, found objects, paper, glass, etc. This 3D Design course heavily the art elements and principles including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, balance, unity, contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, Rhythm. It is designed to help students practice observing the world accurately and objectively, know how to convert two dimensional ideas to three dimensional spaces, and break out of the box and be ingenuitive in whatever area of focus they choose to pursue. We also discuss multiple facets of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today. Much of what we create in this class is both artistic and utilitarian.

## Art 7:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) Art 7 is a course made for the exploration of the arts! We use a variety of media in this class to help you unlock the creative genius inside yourself. This beginning Art 7 course explores the art elements including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, and touches on the art principles of design including: Balance, Unity, Contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, and Rhythm. It is an introduction course for 7<sup>th</sup> graders who wish to explore different art media and experiment with creativity. We discuss multiple areas of art history so that students learn to make literary connections to the world around them.

## Beginning Art 8:

(\$15.00 Class Fee) This Beginning Art 8 course is an introduction to the arts and the many different types of art you can make! It explores the art elements including: Line, Shape, Value, Form, Color, Texture, Space, and touches on the art principles of design including: balance, unity, contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, Rhythm. It is an introductory course that allows students to explore creativity by using a variety of art media. It is designed to help students practice observing the world accurately and objectively, and learn how to harness their creativity. We also discuss multiple areas of art history so students may make literary connections to past art and what it means today.
